2018 in Summary

Staffing was certainly one of the more high impact point for the Police Department in 2018. We lost several key people who decided to move on for various reasons. Sergeant Dave Bonneau r after 34 years of service with the department in January moved on to enjoy a well-deserved retirement. This created the need for a new Sergeant and Officer Jason Burke was promoted Sergeant and has performed remarkable well.

Also, Officers Eric Quatrano, Jacob Hollis and Animal Control Officer Lisa Cronk resigned for various personal and professional reasons. Additionally, we worked through a long-term medical absence of an officer. Not only does it hurt to lose well respected people with whom we have solid relationships with, the staffing shortages created as a result creates more of a demand on our existing staff. As expected, team work and commitment allowed us to work through these shortages.

We were able to attract and hire high quality people to back fill openings, officers Alex Brokos and Derek Axelson, were hired starting out their careers. Officer Al LeBlanc was bought on after a very successful 20 yr. career in Westbrook. We are fortunate to have these officers join our department. Additionally we hired Jackie Frye a very effective and experienced Animal Control officer who seamlessly transitioned into the position to provide this essential service to the town.

We also completed a hiring process to hire Officer Rob Hamilton who will attend the MCJA in January 2019. This hiring achieves our goal of hiring the 28th sworn officer.

Some programming high points was the implementation of a trial period of a team concept schedule presented by the patrol bureau. This scheduling allows for more consistent working hours with officers and their assigned Sergeant, it also allows for a more consistent schedule and week end time for our officers. While still in its trial period of one year, the schedule appears to be working especially when fully staffed.

We have successfully implemented a UAV (drone program) being one of the first municipal departments in the state to do so. The advanced technology has proven very effective particularly mapping and document the scene of serious motor vehicle crashes.

Through the budget development process, another less lethal option was presented accepted and implemented. The 40MM launchers have been procured, a policy developed and necessary training completed.
