Budget Drivers and Influences

Projected Slight Increase in Revenues

- Excise Tax Increase
- Interest Income

General Operating Budget

- Fixed expenses;
 - Insurances
 - Workers Comp, General Liability & Casualty, Health Care.
 - Contractual obligations (service suppliers, GPCOG, MMA, etc.)
 - Energy (electric, propane gas, diesel and gasoline)
 - Long Term Contracts, Debt expenditures, Wages
- Personnel changes/additions
 - Convert ½ time Community Resources Liaison to full time
 - 4 FF/EMT Response Personnel
 - Public Works Operations Manager

Finance Committee Recommendations

- Wage Increase adjusted from 3% to 4% costing \$217,640
 - \$81,000 expenditure was added to the Manager's budget to accomplish this and remain competitive in comparison to neighboring towns.
- Increase Paving Budget by \$366,415 to augment \$750,000 annual investment in resurfacing roadways. Past project bond closure funds were applied to debt reduction freeing debt payment funds to be reallocated to paving.
- \$30,000 Solar credit identified
- Excise Tax Revenue increased by \$200,000
- Interest Income increased by \$113,900

Finance Committee Recommendations

- Total Expenses increased by \$417,415
- Total Revenues increased by \$680,315
- Net reduction to Manager's budget of \$262,900

Long- and Short-Term Debt

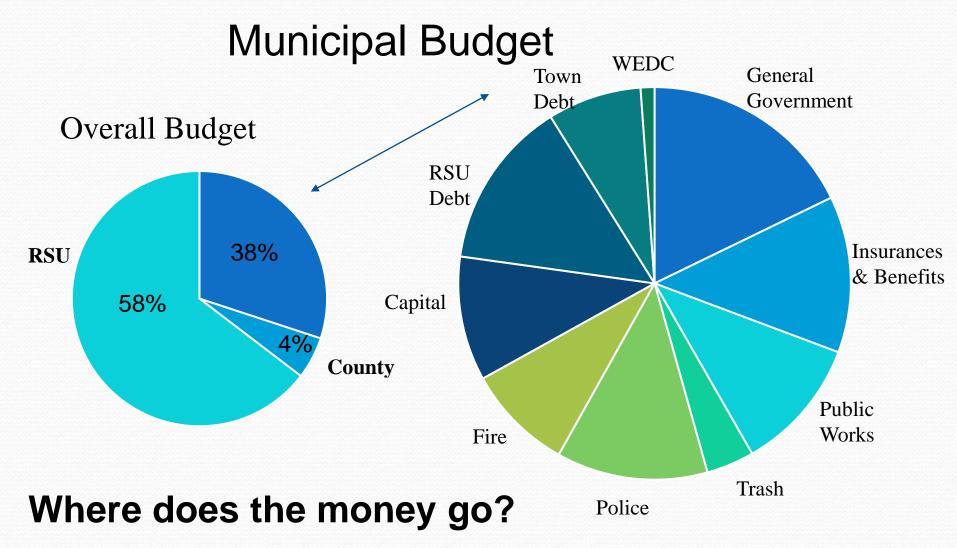
- Long-Term Debt (bond at \$3.7M)
 - S.W. Sidewalk Blue Seal/Depot St. Sidewalk, (PACTS/CDBG \$600k Bond \$689k)
 - River Rd/Rte. 202 intersection- (MPI 50/50 MDOT- \$1.68M Bond \$1.38M)
 - Self Contained Breathing Apparatus \$535k, Engine 5 \$850K, Tower 3/Ladder 21 \$500K w/ grant and shared w/ Gorham
 - Paving \$750K
 - Smith Cemetery \$400K
 - Gambo PWD Land \$750K

Long- and Short-Term Debt

- Short-Term Debt (heavy equipment and vehicles \$915k-Leases)
 - Trackless sidewalk machine, 10-wheel plow truck, pickup truck, light plow truck
- Small Equipment
 - Fire, Public Works, Police, Surveying, Printers/Copiers, Trail Improvements
- Reserve for Future Debt (\$250K)

Legal Debt Limitation is 15% of State Valuation \$2,914,100,000 or \$437,115,000 The Town's current total indebtedness (Town and School) is \$25,641,000 this is .88% of the state valuation, so the Margin for additional borrowing is: \$411,474,000. Bonding Agencies recommend that an average of 12 to 14% of the total operating budget as debt service is consistent to addressing infrastructure needs.

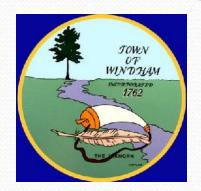
