**Department Restructuring:** With the 2017 /18 budget commencing July 1<sup>st</sup>, we are have begun to implement the restructuring of the police department as presented to the town council, department members and budget committee. A written test has been prepared and is scheduled to be administered on Tuesday August 29, 2017. This will begin the process of establishing an eligibility list for the upcoming year to fill any Sergeants positions which may become available. As reported, the restructure proposal has included to deputy department head positions. These positions will be a Captain of Detectives and Support Serves and a Captain of Patrol. Lieutenant Boudreau will have a title change to Captain of Support Services; a testing process has begun to fill the new position of Captain of Patrol. All existing Sergeants and Officers with 15 years or more experience are eligible to compete for this position. This process will include and in basket project, an oral board panel and a Chief's interview of top candidates.

I wish everyone the best of luck in these processes and would like to thanks everyone who provided input, in particular the committee that did so mush to help put this proposal forward.
