Private Roads Ordinance Work.

Staff is working on ideas discussed at the meeting of September 20, 2016.

Local Regulation of Consumer Fireworks.

The ordinance adopted at the meeting of October 25, 2016 will take effect November 26, 2016. Print, electronic, and social media updates have been issued, the online permitting system is being put in place, and other notification will be done before the effective date.

Anglers Road.

Signal mast arms and signals are to be installed no later than December 5, 2016. These are the last major components of the intersection project.

South Windham Fire Station.

This project is also nearing completion, now expected for early to mid-December. Water damage reported during recent heavy rains due to leaks in the roof turned out to be negligible; repairs to the roof have been arranged.
