**July 2017**

**New Hire:** In July we welcomed the newest addition to the Windham Police Department. Jacob Hollis was sworn in on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Jake comes to us after serving five years with the Philadelphia Police Department. Jake was brought before the board of directors of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy in July. After presenting his training from the Philadelphia Police Academy as well as his experience and in-service training the board has voted to grant him a waiver for full time police officer certification in the State of Maine pending the completion of Maine Crash and OUI / SFST training. With the addition of Jake we are currently fully staffed at our budgeted authorization of 27 sworn officers.

**Community Policing:** After the school year was completed, Officer Cyr took 20 of the DARE to Adventure members, 7th & 8th graders to a ropes course at the Middle School and then to the Forks for white water rafting & rock climbing. These activities are the culmination of the years' work where participants learn leadership skills and healthy risk taking decision making skills. These activities allow participants to demonstrate new levels of confidence and self-esteem, as well as team work and support under the mentorship of officer Cyr.
