Good afternoon,

On February 10th, 2026 EPA published an update on the next steps for the Keddy Mill Superfund Site. The Site will be cleaned up in multiple phases. The first phase includes demolition and removal of the building, with the potential exception of the westernmost wall, under a Non-Time-Critical Removal Action. Following this work, soil, sediment, and groundwater will be cleaned up under a Remedial Action. During each of these steps, reuse for the site is taken into consideration.
