Dear Windham Citizens:

LifeFlight is closely aligned with Maine values. It is about neighbor helping neighbor in a vast, rural state where a severely injured or ill person can be hours away from the nearest major medical center. LifeFlight, working closely with local EMS and rescue personnel, brings the expertise, technology, and care of the major centers directly to a patient's side. This rapid access to specialized care is often the difference between life and death.

Since LifeFlight began operating 17 years ago we have safely transported nearly 20,000 patients, from premature infants to the most complex cardiac surgical patients. They have come from 441 of Maine's 456 towns—truly LifeFlight has become **of** Maine. In the last fiscal year, we transported 2 Windham residents, and 36 total since 1998.

We are proud that LifeFlight of Maine is nationally recognized as a leader for quality, innovation, safety, and cost. As you might have seen in recent press LifeFlight has expanded by adding an airplane and plans to add a third helicopter in the coming year. These aircraft are needed in order to answer requests for service, which increased by 17% between 2014 and 2015.

LifeFlight was founded on the belief that critical care and transport must be available for all people in Maine regardless of their insurance coverage or ability to pay. Last year LifeFlight provided over \$1.6 million dollars of charity care to patients without resources. Although LifeFlight of Maine has the lowest charges in the country, it is still expensive to provide state of the art medical care and high speed transport. We rely on fundraising to support the costs of capital expenses including aircraft, very specialized life-saving medical equipment, helipad construction and delivery of local level EMS education.

Support for LifeFlight comes from a variety of sources including municipalities from all over the state: 109 Maine towns and cities have contributed to LifeFlight, most through their annual social service budgets, in amounts ranging from \$100 to \$2500. Many Rotary, Lions and Kiwanis clubs, local businesses, EMS and Fire Departments, along with foundations and individuals, also support the mission. Without the collective help from all contributors each year, LifeFlight could not continue to meet the growing need. Collectively town giving is making a huge impact and helps LifeFlight maintain its high standard of care for everyone in need.

Windham has an opportunity to join these efforts by including LifeFlight in your municipal budget. Many towns choose to use our suggested formula of donating \$1 per person, recognizing that each municipality is different and any level of donation is welcome. Please consider allocating a donation of \$2000 to LifeFlight. Help us keep families and communities whole one flight at a time.






