Success: One way of defining success at accomplishing our mission is:

To respond effectively to all Domestic Violence Assaults

Computer challenges:

CCRCC Dispatchers operated two separate Databases, IMC and Spillman. The Windham Police Department has used IMC for 10+ years. We converted to Spillman On January 6, 2014. IMC populates the radio log & the call takers log into the initial Call for service. Spillman separates the Call for Service, the call taker screens and the Unit radio logs.

It is very difficult to search all the logs separately.

Three Elements:

- Identify Predominate Aggressor
- Victim issued WPD D/V Info Packet
- Windham Police Officer(s) "shall make contact with the victim within (48) hours of all Domestic Abuse Incidents"

Indicator:

Percentage of interventions applied to Domestic/Violence calls (number of elements X number of calls)

12 arrests X 3 elements for each arrest = 36 elements possible Minus 4 elements not determined = 32 elements possible We completed 26 out of 32 elements.

Performance Measurement:

26 elements = 32 elements = 81% Success rate for this exercise.
