



Windham Public Library Report May 2017



Mission, Success, Measurement

One way that the library defines success at our mission is by ensuring that we continue to be a gateway to technology. We assist patrons by providing training to use personal devices and public access computers as well as specific programs, such as setting up email accounts or applying for jobs online. In addition, we offer technology for our youngest patrons. We have a computer preloaded with specially curated software to build literacy and technology skills. This summer, with the assistance of a Maine Public Library Fund grant, we'll be adding iPads in the Children's Room. The iPads will have educational apps loaded as well as other equipment that will be used with the iPads to enhance the children's learning experience. The library thanks the Maine State Library for providing grants through Maine State Tax checkoff funds to support this project.

What's going on?

May 2 was the final day for the second grade Junior Achievement sessions for Joyce Whidden's and Jenny Hopkins' classes. Visits were also made to Birchwood, Creative Explorations, and Little Log Cabin Montessori School during the month. It was the end of the year visit for two of the three preschools.

Tea was held on Tuesday, May 30, with about 30 folks stopping by to enjoy ice box cakes, new crackers, and cheese.

The Summer Reading Program scheduling, programming, and paperwork were a major focus of the month. It is good to have most of that in place.

The library's 3rd annual Star Wars Day celebrations were great fun for all who attended (and many who looked on!). We had 53 attendees (36 kids and 17 adults) who did scavenger hunts, coloring pages, lightsaber crafts, and other activities to celebrate the day. A special photo backdrop was set up for those who wanted their picture taken—in Star Wars costume or not—and 25 colorful shots were posted on the library facebook page. Casablanca Comics and Bull Moose generously donated comic books, gift certificates and trading cards to give away as prizes for the popular scavenger hunt.

Two library staff (Jen Dupree and Sally Bannen) attended a workshop through the Sebago Lakes Chamber of Commerce along with other local business leaders. "How to be calmly powerful under stress" was a useful workshop that explored new ways to view stressful situations and your reactions to them.
