Project Home's unique model — partnering with landlords, removing barriers, training tenants, guaranteeing units, and delivering ongoing management without requiring a voucher — is virtually unheard of in the United States. We unlock access, providing the housing navigation needed not only to place vulnerable tenants in a home but the year-long-stabilization to keep them there.

2,402 households

have been helped by Project Home — more than **5,500 adults and children** from every county in Maine — achieve stable housing through collaborations with over **1,100 landlords** since 2018.

At the same time that we work to get the unhoused into apartments, we work to stabilize those who are at the greatest risk of eviction. When you live paycheck-to-paycheck, even the smallest unplanned expense— a medical emergency or even simply a new prescription— threatens the ability to pay the rent. We provide in-home visits that evaluate needs and connect residents to the healthcare services and help families weather unpredicted emergencies to stay in their homes.
