Port Resources manages two group homes in the town of Windham. Eight adults with developmental disabilities and mental health challenges and in some cases ambulatory limitations reside in these two homes. Each home has an array of needs relating to energy efficiency, aging home equipment and infrastructure issues. The two homes and their addresses are listed below. I have also included the estimated funds needed for each location.

Replace living room, dining room and kitchen flooring -	\$4500.00

SHARED LIVING (SL) SERVICES

Shared Living is similar to foster care. It is a family support model where individuals with intellectual disabilities join a family. Shared Living providers support the client with:

- Interpersonal skill development
- Scheduling of appointments and activities
- Community inclusion

ADULT HOME AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES

This service focuses on enhancing an individual's quality of life, and developing and maintaining their skills that support their health and well-being.


