Kirk,

In addition to the approval for pit closure requirement, I had attached the two new comments from the town engineer:

- "1. I understand that the maintenance access road will be superelevated from STA 1+00 to end to direct the flow toward the meadow buffer by since I have been involved in discussions and meetings on this, however I still feel it would helpful to orient someone looking at the plan as to what direction to super elevate by labeling the cross-section A-A' or E-W. I don't think it does this." Please see plan sheet C-4 attached with red clouds. The plan view has been revised to include a cross section A-A designation at approximately station 7+40.
- "2. My one question/comment on the level spreader is that it shows 1/3 of it under the line of solar panels. Will this be an issue in constructing either of these items?" Construction of the level spreader and solar racking will not be an issue. Construction sequence will be to install the level spreader first, followed by the racking system. The foundation post for the racking system is adjustable, allowing for the support post to be installed outside the footprint of the level spreader.
