## 5K Run/Walk for Autism Nets \$8,300 for Preschools

#### Sibshops Now Accepting Fall Enrollment



The Sibshop program is a free monthly activity club and peer support group for siblings of children with special needs. Sibshop provides fun and meaningful opportunities for siblings to meet each other, interact with peers who share a unique bond, and learn from each other how to cope with challenging family situations.

Children ages 6 to 11 years of age, who have a brother or sister with a developmental or intellectual disability, or mental health issues, are eligible to participate. The program runs throughout the school year, meeting on the first Friday afternoon of each month, and is free to families.
