Please be advised that the speed zones described in the attached memorandum for River Road in the Town of Windham have been approved. It was necessary to adjust the speed zoning on the northern and southern approaches to the roundabout at the intersection with Windham Center Road. The official speed zone on these 2 approaches has been established as 35 MPH. No other changes in the speed zoning on River Road have taken place (refer to attached memorandum).

In the next few weeks, the Department will make all necessary adjustments to the signage associated with speed zoning for this area.

The Director of Maintenance and Operations concurred with a recommendation by the State Traffic Engineer that the following speed zoning be established on River Road in the Town of Windham as described below:

RESCIND: Zone ID 2754072 (50 MPH Zone) and Zone ID 2754079 (45 MPH Zone).

ADOPT: 50 MPH beginning at a point 0.18 miles north of the junction with Riverside Ridge Road (Node 19515) and extending southerly to a point 0.13 miles beyond the junction with Colby Drive (Node 62830), a total distance of 1.06 miles,

35 MPH beginning at a point 0.11 miles south of Colby Drive (Node 62810) and extending southerly to a point 0.05 miles north of the junction with Presumpscot Road (Node 15964), a total distance of 0.40 miles.
