## Monthly Report

August 2016

Last month I reported on efforts undertaken to help address the opioid abuse disorder crisis in our community. One project reported on was the implementation of our Nasal NARCAN program. By way of reminder, Nasal NARCAN is an opioid antagonist that reverses the effects of respiratory arrest caused by opioids. With the hard work of Officer Ernie MacVane, our officers have been trained and carry Narcan while on duty. Since the inception of the program, Windham Police Officers have utilized Narcan on two people who were suffering from an opiate overdose, most likely saving their lives.

Also, I am pleased to report that the Substance Abuse Assistance grant worked on with Westbrook, Gorham and Buxton was submitted to the State for review, we were one of several groups who were awarded grant monies to help combat this crisis. Meetings to implement the program have been set; hopefully the program can get rolled out in the near future. The goal of this program will be to provide staff as a conduit between Law Enforcement and Recovery coaches to identify people in need, provide them with access to treatment and other required resources. We are excited to help pioneer this project and provide a much needed service to our community.
