North Windham Fire Station Repurpose Advisory Committee

Purpose

The purpose of the North Windham Fire Station Repurpose Advisory Committee will be to serve as an advisory body to the Town Council for the analysis of potential re-use for the North Windham Fire Station's renovation design, documentation, construction and potential benefit as a North Windham Economic Incubator. The Committee will provide a comprehensive recommendation to the Council for its consideration.

Councilors shall be appointed by the Town Council as a whole and the members of the public following application to and recommendation by the Council's Appointments Committee.

The Committee shall elect a Chair and Vice Chair at its first regular meeting or as soon as possible thereafter from within its membership, except that the Town Council representatives shall not be eligible to serve as Chair or Vice Chair.

- 1. Two (2) members of the Town Council,
- 2. Town Manager (non-voting member)
- 3. Assistant Town Manager (non-voting member),
- 4. Economic Development Director (non-voting member),
- 5. Three (3) WEDC Board members,
- 6. Facilities & Grounds Manager (non-voting member),
- 7. Director of Planning (non-voting member),
- 8. St. Joseph's College or local college representative, and
- 9. Two (2) members of the public (not on WEDC).

Charge:

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to:

- 1. Research the best uses of the building / land / space.
- 2. Research and evaluate various incubator centers to develop a model business plan.
- 3. Develop alternative governance structures.
- 4. Develop a SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats) Analysis on condition of the facility, location and future town needs.
- 5. Utilize an engagement process with businesses and residents to identify development opportunities for Windham with an incubator.
- 6. Consider alternative uses in conjunction with the incubator as appropriate.
- 7. Develop a concept plan within the boundaries of the existing building as appropriate.
- 8. Develop a preliminary scope of project with construction costs for Council review and next steps.

Sunset Provision:

This committee shall automatically terminate upon its reported recommendations to the Town Council unless they opt to extend the time of termination.
