Quarterly Report for Period of April 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026

Highlights and Accomplishments:

- ❖ Courtesy letters were mailed in mid-April to residents with outstanding property tax balances due. When these letters were mailed, 885 real estate and 190 personal property accounts showed a delinquent balance. Staff continued collection efforts in the subsequent months by reaching out to residents via phone. These efforts culminated in a final total of 218 real estate and 30 personal property accounts remaining with a balance due as of June 30, 2026; a reduction of 76.9% from the totals in mid-April.
- ❖ One staff member was cross trained on the new voting registration system to assist Town Clerks as needed.
- ❖ We continue to support professional development for Town staff; three staff members attended separate Maine Municipal Association/MMTCTA training sessions.
- ❖ Collected a total of \$1,459,448.07 in excise tax during this period.
- ❖ Transaction volumes processed during the period:

Challenges:

- ❖ The State of Maine is experiencing an ATV sticker shortage due to an issue with the purchasing process on their end. This has resulted in us receiving very limited quantities of stickers. The State has instructed us that these stickers should only be issued for new registrations and that all re-registrations should be completed online. In response to this, we have been assisting residents with the online re-registration process at Town Hall upon request.
