WINDHAM HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: This committee will actively assist the Town of Windham in determining the level and type of human service needs to contribute to the welfare and happiness of Windham experienced by the residents, of the Town including, but not limited to, emergency food and clothing. Under the direction of, and in cooperation with professional staff, this committee will recommend to the Town Council appropriate actions to meet identified needs.

MEMBERSHIP: The committee shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Town Council for staggered three (3) year terms according to the prescribed processes. All members will be accountable to the Town Council.

SPECIFIC CHARGE: It shall be the responsibility of the committee to prepare findings for consideration by the Town Council in the following areas:

- a) Identify the short term human service needs of the community and to recommend appropriate programs to meet those needs. Coordinate with residents and local agencies to provide appropriate services through on-going community outreach and to review as needed.
- b) Identify the long-term human service needs of the community and recommend appropriate programs to meet those needs.
- c) Coordinate with other community-based resources to ensure the efficient delivery
 of assistance.
- d) Review and recommend to the Town Manager budgetary requests by social service agencies.
