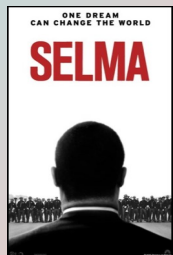
Black History Month movie series Fridays, 5:30-7:40pm

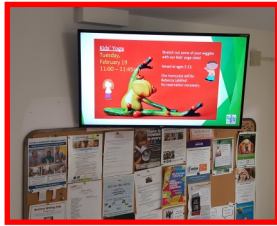


Chat with the Director

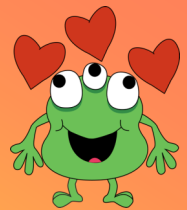
Drop-In Osmo Time Friday, February 8th 10:30am-5pm

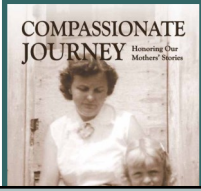
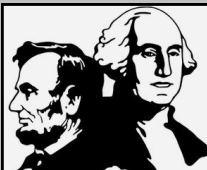
