The fire rescue department are all set with the Cross Ridge Subdivision as proposed. However, we are requesting that each cistern to be installed to the NFPA 22 Standard. Also, our hard suctions are 6" not 4.5" as listed, so the adapter needs to be 6" on the suction pipe. And, we will need a 2.5" recirculation pipe added to the tank as well as a water level gauge indictor. The gauge must be visible from a vehicle or fire apparatus.
