The Code Enforcement Officer may issue up to Five (5)² growth permits from the reserve pool each calendar year for detached single-family dwellings to the person(s) who will own and occupy the dwelling upon completion of construction, provided that there are no growth permits available from the monthly allocation and they have missed an allocation for the previous two permit monthly issuances. These permits shall be issued according to the order in which they were approved as complete, and the basis of points earned pursuant to Section G.4.d. Permits issued under this section shall not be transferable.

If the Town Council determines a project to be eligible to receive growth permits from the reserve pool, the record owner of the property shall apply for a growth permit for each dwelling unit in accordance with Sec. 101-7 (G) (4)
