



Windham Public Library Report May 2018

The day to day business at the library has started to return to normal after the completion of the renovation. The Maine Student Book Award Ice Cream Party was held on Monday, May 7. We had a great turn out with good conversation and participants were excited to have a chance to check out books for next year.

Diana Currier, Children's Room Coordinator, was in charge of the tea on Tuesday, May 8. More than 25 patrons enjoyed two types of delicious pie, fruit, cheese and crackers.

Gigi McAllister, who is currently serving on the statewide Maine Student Book Award Committee, stopped by to learn about how to help strengthen the CloudLibrary with current MSBA titles. This is a project that needed to change hands to keep it strong going forward. Gigi is well prepared and connected to make it a smooth transition.

Visits were made to both Birchwood and Little Log Cabin Montessori School. The Windham Primary School had a Community Day on Thursday, May 17 at which the kindergarten classes at the school presented the Children's Room with a check for \$1,163.05. Two days later 143 books had been purchased with the funds for which the library staff is most grateful. During the presentation at the Primary School, students also honored Mrs. Parker for her retirement on September 4th. It was a special presentation as Mrs. Parker has fostered lasting relationships with students in the community through her work at the library. Two third grade classes from Windham Primary School visited the library to see the new renovations on Monday, May 21. That visit was followed on the 24th by three kindergarten classes from the same school.

Plans have been finalized for the Library's involvement in Summerfest. Library staff members and patrons will be marching in the parade with our antique truck decorated with the Summer Reading theme "Libraries Rock!".
