The Code Enforcement department utilizes an electronic recordkeeping system where you may query our software for building permits, inspection notes, and final occupancy issuances, etc. by property address.

Property Record Search

- Current Permits & Inspections (2015-Present): Use the [MyGov Portal](#) to search for active and completed permits, inspection notes, and code enforcement files by address.
- Legacy Records (Prior to 2015): Visit [AxisGIS - Windham](#) to search for older building documents and historical files.
 - Instructions: Search by address → Click on Property → Select "Building Docs" beneath the "Documents" subheading.

The Fire-Rescue Department indicated that they did not have any records that meet this request. Their only responses to the address have been for medical and alarms. There are no records of underground storage tanks. We believe our online portals will provide all the information we have on hand.
