Designated Private Ways – Compliance with L.D. 1975

September 9, 2022 Progress Report

Of the **Designated Private Ways**, the Town is currently providing winter maintenance services:

- Council has accepted easements from **8 associations**, representing **11 roads**, serving <u>279</u> <u>abutting parcels</u>.
- Council at its meeting of September 13, 2022, will act to accept **1 easement**, from an association representing **1 road**, serving <u>38 abutting parcels</u>.
 - ➢ With this action, 12% of the roads that qualify for winter maintenance as defined by L.D. 1975 have complied with the law for continued services.
- We still need to obtain easements from **88 roads**, representing <u>1,313 abutting parcels</u>.
 - We have confirmation of <u>21</u> associations, representing <u>41 roads</u> and <u>813 abutters</u> working towards having their meetings & getting their easement signatures.
 - This is (41%) of the roads that qualify for winter maintenance to continue upon compliance with <u>L.D. 1975</u>.
 - We have heard from individuals of <u>23</u> roads, representing <u>234 abutting parcels</u>, who have made inquiries or have taken steps developing/formalizing an association and inquired about the easement requirements. (23%)
 - We have not heard from representatives of <u>24</u> roads, representing <u>266 abutting</u> <u>parcels</u>. (24%)
