Rick & Erik,

Dave Waddell and I discussed your project earlier today. We understand that the apartment building project was approved by DEP in #L-23535-NB-D-A, which is attached to this email. We also have heard from the Town that during the process of obtaining a license from the Town of Windham, modifications and revisions were made to the project that differ from what the Department approved. Items that changed during the local review include:

- Relocation of the emergency spill way to the same location as the primary outlet.
- Discharging underdrain of the sand filter into an UDSF.
- Eliminating one of the three rows of Cultec Chambers

- UDSF design changes that reduce the volume treated.
- Combining two UDSFs into one oversized UDSF.
- Modeling at least one UDSF as infiltrating.
- Change to the rainfall used in the HydroCAD model
  - New plans are dated 10/14/22

If this is the case, you must submit a Minor Amendment application to the DEP to gain approval for the revised project.

It is important to note, that the DEP's current license only approves the project shown on the plan set consisting of six plans, the first of which is titled "Roosevelt Apartment Homes, 965 Roosevelt Trail, Windham, Maine, Tax Map 21, Lot 19A for Heyland Development LLC," prepared by Engineering Alliance Inc., and dated February 26, 2021 with a latest revision date on any of the sheets of April 11, 2022. Construction should not begin until you have obtained the appropriate approval from DEP. (I want to note that DEP staff are currently overwhelmed with the volume of applications and it will take months to review the required modification / amendment. Please plan accordingly). Construction of a project that varies from the approved plan set is a violation of the Department's license and will be referred to enforcement.
