PROGRAM/FACILITY HIGHLIGHTS

<u>Senior Trips</u> – We had two senior trips in September. The first to the Wells and Ogunquit Historical Society and lunch at Mike's Clam Shack. 15 seniors enjoyed this trip with a special stop at Congdon's donut shop. On September 25th we had 20 seniors take a trip to the D.E.W. Animal Sanctuary in Mt. Vernon. A good time was had by all with over the 200 different animals at the sanctuary.
