Report.

Anglers Road.

There is currently no work being done on this project as we wait for the new mast arms and signals to come in. Due to the timing, we may put temporary signals in place to get the intersection done and working the way it should and install the permanent signals later in the fall.

South Windham Fire Station.

Construction continues on this project. By the end of this week the additional steel purlins will have been installed in the roof as part of the structural modifications. Additional cross-bracing is expected to be installed next week, followed by insulation crews, and the start of framing the offices, community room, etc. Project meeting notes for August 3 are attached to the legislative file with this report. This project is included in the projects and issues list and sheets as TMP-0549.

Private Roads Ordinance Work.

Further discussion on private roads (following up on the latest discussion at the meeting of July 26, 2016) has been scheduled tentatively for September 6.

Local Regulation of Consumer Fireworks.

A discussion item on local regulation of consumer fireworks has been rescheduled for the September 6, 2016 meeting. The fire-rescue and police chiefs also have been asked to be prepared to comment and participate in the discussion.
