Monthly Report February 2017

Projects:

Homeland Security Grant: Our grant to install proximity card / tab readers on our doors at the public safety building is in full swing. We are on the work list for Norris Security to begin the project sometime during the month of April. Due to the final quote coming in under the initial proposal, there are surplus funds available to allow the north Windham Fire Station to be completed as well.

Traffic Enforcement: In addition to the extra patrols paid for by the Bureau of Highway Safety grant, we have asked our patrol force to prioritize traffic enforcement when possible. I am pleased to report that for the month of February our traffic stops and citations are up significantly from January, 352 stops, 109 citations and 133 warnings. Communication from the public at our MDOT River Road meeting reinforced how important this is to our citizens. I want to thank everyone for their efforts and for a job well done!!

Staffing: Currently we still have one vacant position based on our budgetary allotment of 27 sworn officers and three non-sworn positions.

Officer Devyn Rogers is in his final stage of field training and performing remarkably well. It is anticipated that he will complete his field training and be ready for assigned patrol duties around the end of the month of March. Officer Jeff Ruth has completed his field training and is being fully utilized in the patrol schedule. Each officer has been received well both throughout the community and within the department, we are fortunate to have them on board.

We are currently performing a background investigation on an out of state certified officer. After a preliminary review of the officers' training records and discussion with the administration of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, there most likely would be a waiver of the full 18 week training academy once certain classes and waiver tests are completed.
