“HISTORIC SOUTH WINDHAM”

WHEREAS South Windham is the location of the corner post for the first lot and the area of first settlements in the Town of Windham

WHEREAS the River Road is the earliest road leading into the Town of Windham

WHEREAS South Windham is the site of the earliest remaining structures and identified archeological remains in the Town of Windham

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the area of South Windham from the corner post for Lot #1 to the town line with the City of Westbrook be designated as “Historic South Windham,” and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Windham hereby supports recognition and awareness of this designation through the placement of informational signs and other means of public communication, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all public projects, improvements, alterations, or modifications of roads, bridges, and other infrastructure in Historic South Windham reflect in their design consideration for and sensitivity to the historic and aesthetic value of this area to the community, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Windham is committed to working in cooperation with the Windham Historical Society to assist in the preservation of and education about Windham’s early history for future generations.
