Highland Views Development, Windham Permit by Rule Application

Dear Mr. Cherry:

On behalf of Chase Custom Homes and Finance, Inc., we are pleased to submit three copies of the attached Permit by Rule Application materials and plans for the Highland project.

We request this application to cross a seasonal stream in two places and to reduce the setback from the stream down to 25' along the development. We have provided several photos of the stream & crossing areas.

We propose to cross the stream in two places. The first can be seen in Photos 1 & 6. This location is just downstream of an existing crossing that will be removed. The second crossing can be seen in Photos 20-22. Both crossing are near 90 degrees and feature a 24" culvert that will be embedded a minimum of 6" to meet the Army Corp of Engineers methodology.

We also propose to reduce the stream setback to 25' in the area adjacent to the manufactured housing lots. Photos 1, 2, 6 & 18-27 show the area. The stream appears to be an old man-made channel that was not maintained and is now functioning as a stream.
