


ON or OFF PREMISE DIAGRAM

Riding To The Top Therapeutic Riding Center

Riding To The Top Therapeutic Riding Center (RTT) is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, incorporated in 1993, dedicated to providing Equine Assisted Activities and Therapies (EAAT). Our mission is:

Our Mission: Enhancing health and wellness through equine assisted activities and therapies.

WHAT: Equine Assisted Activities and Therapies (EAAT) involve the entire farm experience—everything from readying one's self (safety awareness, use of a helmet, etc.) and the horse for riding (grooming, tacking, leading the horse), to developing relationships with the instructor, horse and volunteers, to the physical and cognitive challenges of riding. EAAT provides the individual with many different forms of feedback—the sensory feedback from touching a horse, the relationships of cause and effect in learning to control a horse, or the thrill of sitting astride a horse, feeling the soothing rhythm of the horse's movements.

WHY: The motions of a horse closely match that of human walking and as such they are perfect for facilitating postural control for people who have physical disabilities. Riding has been shown to reduce abnormal muscle tone (spasticity) and improve balance and coordination. EAAT and the personal relationships that develop (people to people and people to horse) help to foster improved self-esteem, trust and self-confidence for individuals with emotional, behavioral and/or learning disabilities.

WHO: RTT serves individuals with a wide range of disabilities including but not limited to cerebral palsy, brain injury, stroke, developmental delays, learning disabilities, multiple sclerosis, many forms of autism and "at risk" youth. Our clients range in age from 3 to 70+, with children representing the majority of our clients. Over 60% of our clients receive some level of scholarship aid. Riding To The Top is a PATH Intl. (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International) Premier Accredited Center. Our instructors are all PATH Certified in therapeutic riding instruction and screened and trained volunteers provide over 12,000 hours of assistance to clients each year.

WHERE/WHEN: Riding To The Top owns a 50-acre farm in Windham, Maine located on Land of Nod Road, near the Windham/Westbrook town line. We are the largest therapeutic riding program in New England and the only year round program solely dedicated to therapeutic riding in Maine. Our comprehensive facility includes a heated indoor arena, attached program and office space, an outdoor arena and miles of trails.

VISION STATEMENT

We are an inclusive community where everyone gives and receives, teaches and is taught. The farm is a place of healing, learning and joy. At RTT, children and adults with disabilities work together with horses, volunteers and staff to overcome their challenges and reach their highest potential. Through engaging in RTT's program, all of our lives are enhanced and broadened in an environment that is supportive, innovative, respectful and diverse.
