Dear Sir,

In reviewing the Assessor's records, I can find no information indicating why the property owned by your organization has been exempt from local real estate taxation.

In order to bring my records up to date, I am reviewing the status of all exempt properties. For this reason would you be so kind as to provide this office with the following information prior to April 30, 1976?

- 1. The full name of the organization.
- 2. A copy of the charter of the organization, if there is one, or other papers establishing the organization.
- 3. The section of Title 36 of the Maine Revised Statutes which specifies exemption for your organization.
- 4. Either a copy of the deed which transferred the property to your organization or the Book and Page numbers where it is recorded.

Depending upon the section of the statute identified as specifying exemption, additional information may be requested.

If the information provided does not clearly indicate that an exemption is warrented, or if no information is provided, property owned by your organization will be listed as taxable for 1976.

If you would like assistance in determining which section of Title 36 applies in your particular case, or if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact this office.
