Psychology whose award-winning research, education, and clinical care focus on patients with memory disorders. Her recent book, co-authored

with Andrew E. Budson, MD, is Seven Steps to Managing Your Memory: What's Normal, What's Not, and What to Do About It. Dr. O'Connor is Assistant Professor of Neurology at Boston University, Director of Neuropsychology at the Bedford Veterans Affairs Hospital, and Member at Large of the National Academy of Neuropsychology.
