#### Mission, Success, Measurement

One way that the library defines success at our mission is by providing opportunities for lifelong learning. Through our programming we host authors, trainers, and presenters who share their expertise with our library patrons to provide information and learning about topics of interest. We have a weekly technology training session, monthly author talks, and in 2018 will begin hosting programs on topics such as financial planning and gardening.

In addition to being able to attend informational programs in person, the library has added a new online learning service called UniversalClass. The UniversalClass database has over 500 online courses for professional or personal growth. All you need is your Windham library card! # What's going on?

In addition to the day to day running of the library, staff members have been preparing for the upcoming renovation. With a start date set for December 11<sup>th</sup>, attention has been focused on packing offices and supplies, organizing, weeding the collection, and preparing for working in a temporary space. Notifications have been sent to local papers and publicized on social media as well as forwarded to community partners such as the Middle School and Baxter Academy, that the library will be closed to prepare our temporary space December 11<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>. I facilitated a discussion between Baxter Academy and RSU#14's Bill Hansen, to move the BA bus drop from the library lot to a parking lot nearby on the school campus. With all the construction equipment and limited parking, a temporary bus drop off was necessary to ensure the safety of the students.

Four library employees participated in the town's 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Windham Community Tree Lighting by supplying two fun activities for the children at the event. Jen Alvino, Jen Dupree & Sally Bannen gave kids 2 minutes to move mini marshmallows from one container to another using pairs of chopsticks. Children then counted their totals and wrote them on a score board. Bragging rights were the reward for the highest player. There were 51 participants in that activity. Mrs. Parker also represented the library with two holiday crafts for kids to create. There were popsicle stick Christmas trees to decorate as well as pipe cleaner candy canes to make. The craft tables were busy all evening as approximately 200 kids designed crafts! It's nice to have several town departments taking part in the event.

Visits were made to Birchwood and Little Log Cabin Montessori School during November.

Youbell Jackson presented a program on her book Cat With an Attitude.

Tea on November 14 was enjoyed by almost 30 folks. Chocolate cake, spice cake, crackers, cheese, and grapes were on the menu.
