A little about the 2017 study: We have an internal software that tracks all of our aggregate (sold or hauled to another location). From this we took the top most active weeks of the year and broke them down by day. The highest singular day had a total of 37 trips for the entire day. Every other trip was under 36 total trips for the day. From this, we feel its apparent that we're under the 36 trips per hour on the conditions of approval.

I've reviewed the submission from Shaw Brothers for the O-Pit monitoring requirements:

- Groundwater Monitoring - No comments
- Traffic – The narrative indicates that the peak daily trips during the 5 week analysis period was 37. Was this data collected using standard traffic counter tubes and if so, can the applicant provide the output sheets for the 5 week analysis period in 2017? Though highly unlikely, it would be good to verify that the 37 trips on the peak day were spread out over the course of the day and did not exceed the 36 allowed in any one hour.
- Noise – No comments.
