1. News/updates

2. Open Space Plan

a. Status of the RFP

Ben will not complete drafting the RFP as it could be conflict of interest if he intends to respond to the RFP as a private consultant. Amanda will finalize the draft as time allows.

- 3. Ordinances
 - a. Zoning Map updates relative to Future Land Use Map
 - i. Determine the boundaries between Growth Areas and Rural Areas
 - ii. Rural Areas identify criterial areas that should have different standards

Discussion of ordinance standards:

- Allow uses that make Windham a destination agricultural accessory uses, recreation, businesses.
- No more private roads in growth areas.
- Cluster subdivisions should be required in rural areas with standards for lot layouts and preservation of existing fields for agriculture or recreation and prioritizing contiguous open space. The Open Space Plan will provide input on prioritizing land that should be in open space.

The Committee reviewed the Zoning Map and the map dated April 3, 2018 where building footprints and public water and sewer where shown with the Future Land Use areas. Discussion of the South Windham growth area boundary and that heavy industrial uses were not appropriate along the Presumpscot River and should be moved to North Windham/ED District.

Consensus that rural areas should be divided into several zoning districts with different standards. Will focus discussion of this concept at the next meeting.
