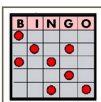

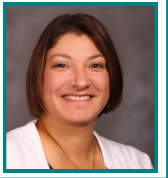

Some exciting changes are in the works at the Windham Public Library:

Beginning in August, our **Reference/Technology Assistant, Ray Marcotte**, will be offering monthly classes on catalog searching and on the cloudLibrary. These classes are free and open to anyone who wants to learn or needs a refresher.

Wednesday, August 1st will kick off **Catalog Class: Become a Savvy Searcher**. This class will teach patrons how to search Minerva and MaineCat efficiently, place holds, avoid fines, and get notified via email or text when holds arrive.

On Wednesday, August 15th, Ray will start **Get your head in the Clouds—Navigating the cloudLibrary**. This class will teach patrons how to checkout e-books and e-audiobooks.

Both classes will run monthly on the first and third Wednesdays from 11am-12pm (*exception: no cloudLibrary class September 2018*). For more information, contact Ray at the Help Desk (207-892-1908).

Ray has also begun **Tech Help Mondays**: free one-on-one technology help from 5:30-6:30pm. This expands our popular Tech Help program which has been offered on Thursday mornings from 10:30-11:30am by library volunteer Gary Conover. Both programs will be available for patrons who require assistance with email, eReaders, tablets, or other tech needs..



Our other big news this month is that **Children's Librarian, Mrs. Parker, will be retiring**. Mrs. Parker started working at the Windham Public Library in 1992 and in 1994 she became the full-time Children's Librarian. Her last day will be September 4th. 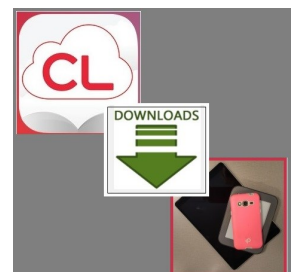


Get Your Head IN the Clouds— Navigating the cloudLibrary! Wednesday, August 15th, 11am-12pm
