What's the most important card in your wallet? Director Jen Alvino says it's your library card. September is library card signup month so

if you don't have a card, now is the time to get one. A Windham Public Library card gives you access to: ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, movies, online classes, print books, and so much more from our library and the more than sixty other libraries in Minerva. That's incredible!

Who can get a library card at our library? Children age five and up can get one. "It's an important rite of passage for any kid entering kindergarten," says Alvino.



Anyone who lives, works, or goes to school in Windham is eligible for a free Windham Public Library card. If you reside and work outside of town, you may pay a \$20.00 non-resident fee per year.

Some favorite books in the Alvino household right now are the **Pete the Cat** series as well as **Elephant and** Piggy. Alvino's older son has been reading the books in A Series of Unfortunate Events, Big Nate and Diary of a Wimpy Kid graphic novels, and the Raina Telgemeier series Smile, Sisters, and Ghost.
