Below are my comments for the project:

- 1. Stormwater:
  - a. Basic Standard An erosion and sediment control plan has been provided that meets Chapter 500.
  - b. General Standard The applicant is utilizing the redevelopment standard that allows for treatment of 60% of the developed area. The site design meets this standard by providing treatment to 61.2% of the newly developed area.
  - c. Flooding Standard Pre & post development stormwater management plans were provided for the project. HydroCAD calculations were not included in the submission and were not reviewed to determine if the flooding standard was met.
  - d. Phosphorus Standard Not applicable.
- 2. Provide copies of the ability to serve letters for water and sewer from PWD once they have been obtained.
- 3. The application did not comment on traffic and I'm assuming the construction of the maintenance & control building will not result in additional peak hour or daily trips?
