Subject: Ruby Meadows, LLC and LLC revival with Secretary of State

Hi Paul and Amanda, I hope this email clears up any confusion on this LLC revival subject. I had to discuss this with my supervisor, Division director and our policy department today for clarification. It is not often that this occurs. For future reference, the easiest thing to do is to just obtain any necessary transfer permit by rules (PBR's) from the Department. They are very simple to get, are not expensive and can be processed quickly. I informed Dustin Roma (former agent who contacted Paul) of this last Monday, Nov 19th.

Result:

If the Secretary of State can confirm that Ruby Meadows, LLC, has been revived and reformed to its original state, then the two permit transfer PBR's (NRPA and Stormwater) for this project will not be required by the Department. However, if the Secretary of State does not allow this revival then these transfer PBR's will be required. Or, if the Secretary of State allows the revival AND stipulates that it may terminate after a period of time, then the Department would need the transfer PBR's at some point in the future.
