



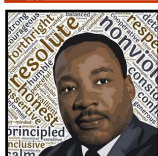

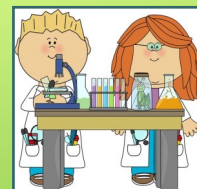

## Chat with the Director



As 2018 draws to a close and we head into 2019, Library Director Jen Alvino reflects on the busy year that has gone by as well as what's to come. In April of 2018, **the library renovation was completed.** As

part of the renovation, we now have two very popular study rooms, four computers designated for teen use, and a new circulation area. The outside of the library got a landscaping facelift, too. We also added a new digital service, Universal Class, and we began our shared borrowing program with the Walker Library in Westbrook and the Gray Library.



2018 also heralded changes in the Children's room, including a second AWE computer, iPads, and of course the hiring of our **new Children's Librarian, Miss Sam.**



We had many successful programs in 2018, including **technology programs** started and run by our Reference and Technology Assistant, Ray, as well as a Maine humanities Council program featuring mysteries by Maine authors, and a Read ME program which included the titles "[Settled in the Wild](#)" and "[River Talk](#)."

In 2019, look for **new afterschool programs.** Running January through June, programs will be on the 1st Thursday of every month (Maker Club), the 2nd Monday (Lego Club), and the 4th Monday (Crafternoon). All programs will run from 3:30-4:30 in the afternoon and will be open to grades 4-6.



In 2018, the library began collaborating with the Windham Police Department, the sheriff's department, area schools, Parks and Recreation, and the Be the Influence Coalition to provide **afterschool events on half days.** We will continue to do that into 2019. This program, Alvino says, offers kids who sign up the opportunity to participate in events "designed to keep kids engaged on early release days."

2018 was a great year, and **we're looking ahead for a fantastic 2019!**

are looking for a few artists to take advantage of it. [Contact Sally at the Library](#) (207-892-1908) for more info.

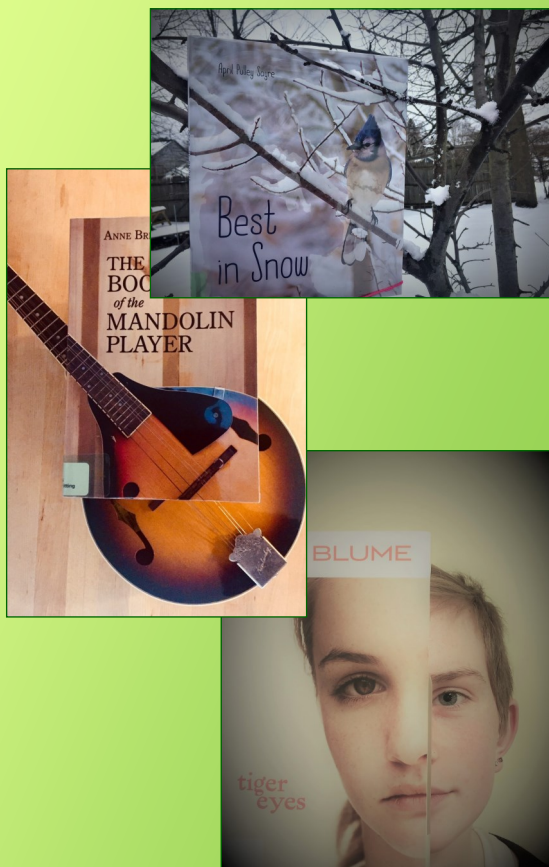
### Seeking Exhibits!

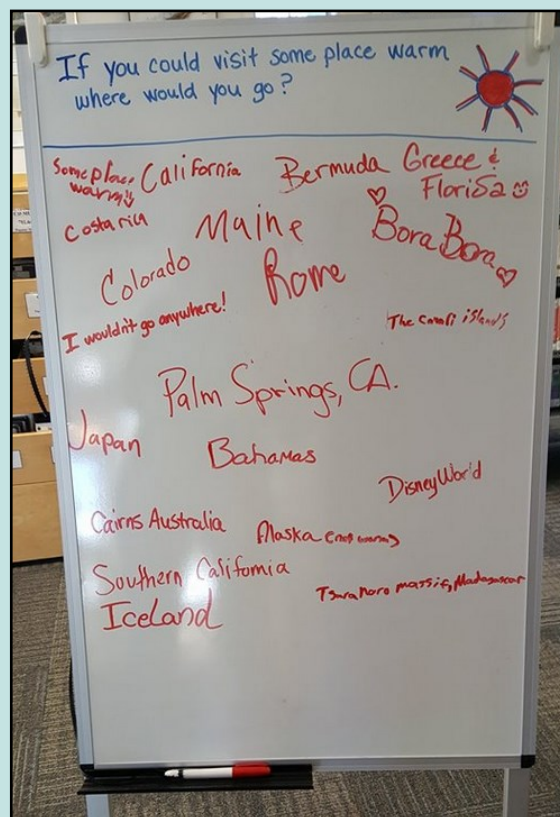
