After review or our current Animal Control Ordinance of the, ACO Jaqueline Frye and I have identified several areas we feel may help improve the ordinance, please see the items listed below.

- Section 81-9 add language to determine time frames for barking, howling etc.
 - Continuous
 - Intermediate
- > Section81-12 Violations and Penalties: Define the term injunctive relief as it relates to the section.
 - Can the town seize a dog after a specified number of sustained violations? Or convictions?
- Consider how many adult dogs a person / family can own
 - Unless they meet requirement as a licensed kennel
- Consider defining a female dog in heart running at large a nuisance dog
- Create a definitions section of the ordinance to define nuisance dog, dangerous dog, dog at large etc.
- Create a component to make property owners responsible / accountable for their tenant and or guest nuisance
