## May 2019 Monthly Report

It is the Mission of Windham Fire-Rescue Department "To assist the residents and visitors with emergencies or other situations that they are normally unable to handle themselves."

#### Performance Measures Related to Our Mission:

Response times are measured from our initial dispatch to when our first unit arrives on the scene. The average day shift response time for May was 6.65 minutes. The average night shift response time was 8.68 minutes. The department's total average response time for May was 7.58 minutes. Our average turn out time which is the time from dispatch to en route was 1.06 minutes.

The department covers six (6) per-diem shifts during the day. In the 31 day period that provides us with 2232 hours of daytime coverage. We had a total of 415 vacant hours during the day and as a result of these open shifts we had reduced coverage during those times. We were able to cover 1817 hours of the 2232 hours for a percentage of coverage at 81.4% a decrease in coverage over last month.

During the night shift the department fills two (2) per-diem shifts for a total of 744 hours. There were 21 hours uncovered at night leaving us covering 723 hours providing us with 97.2% coverage.

With the additional staffing added over the last two years we now have a paramedic 100% of the time at Central Station and North Station.

Our training performance during May has decreased from last month. The department had 415.25 total training hours for the month.

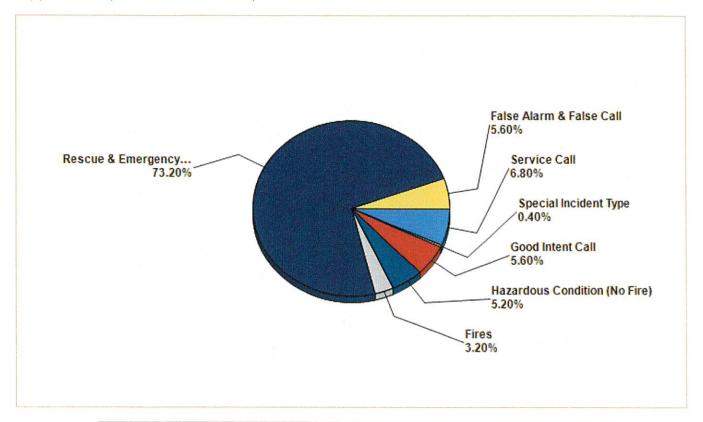

The professionals that are part of this team provide care to the sick and injured with professionalism, precision and compassion. I am thankful to be a part of this great family and to know that you're the ones answering the call THANK YOU!!
- We participated in the live-in student draft selection process. We have selected three new students to fill our college live in positions at East Windham and South Windham Stations for the fall semester.
- We had published a request for proposal for our medical billing service. We sent the RFP to 11 companies/departments that do medical billing. We received one reply; the interim town manager will be entering into a contract with Medical Reimbursement Services of Windham to continue this service for us.
- Our Mechanic has been working through all department vehicles for annual/routine maintenance and State of Maine inspection stickers.
- The firefighters union has been working with the Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) to conduct fundraising for the group. The union and several other members have participated in a boot drive and will also be doing tip a firefighter with Applebee's in June and another boot drive.

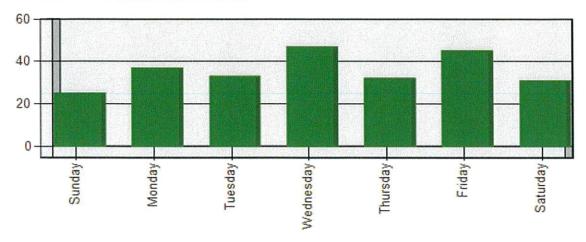

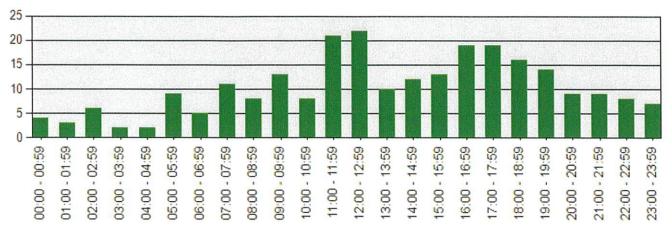

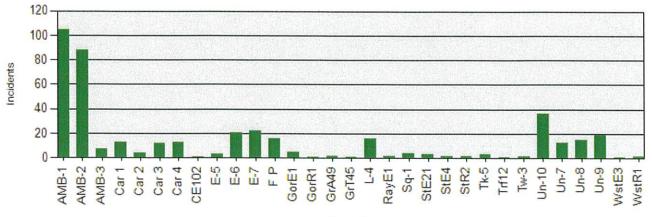

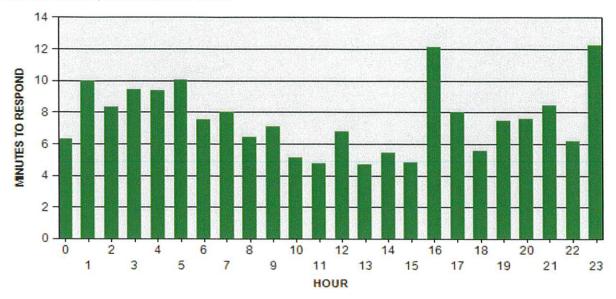
