# MOTION PICTURE THEATERS CHAPTER 153

## § 153-1. License required.

No one shall operate a motion-picture theater in the Town of Windham without having obtained a license therefor <u>from the Town Clerk</u> as provided in this chapter.

## § 153-2. Application.

The application for a license shall be on a form provided by the Town Clerk.

#### § 153-3. Application fee.

Each application shall be accompanied by a fee according to the following schedule: one-hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per screen, except for the initial year when the fee will be prorated based on the number of months remaining before the next license expiration date as established in Section 4 of this ordinance. ## § 153-4. Expiration of license.

License granted hereunder shall expire on September 1. Licenses shall not be assignable.

# § 153-5. Prohibited exhibits.

No license shall exhibit any motion picture which, in whole or in part, depicts nudity, sexual conduct, sexual excitement or sadomasochistic abuse, when it:

- A. Predominately appeals to the prurient, shameful, lustful or morbid interest in sexual conduct.
- B. Is patently offensive to prevailing standards in the community; and
- C. Is utterly without redeeming social value.

# § 153-6. Violations and penalties.

Any violation of this chapter may subject the offender to a civil penalty of not more than one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) or, after notice and hearing, suspension or revocation of this license or both.
