**Equipment:** Through the federal DEA, the Windham Police Department was awarded a TRU NARC drug testing system. The system utilized laser technology to analyzing the molecular structure of a suspected drug, to provide a presumptive test often times required to take legal action on the scene of a crime, while this does not replace the necessity to do further testing, it is a much more efficient, accurate and safe methodology to perform these tests. In addition of the equipment training is provided as well, this is an approximately \$30,000 [piece of equipment.
