Good morning Linda,

Regarding the pole permit on Junco drive, this was installed by our contractor Hector Picard, of private power services. We had them install this to speed up the infrastructure installation over Cmp. Hector has filed all the paperwork with CMP for them to take over ownership of this pole as soon as it is energized.

Once CMP receives a pole permit, they will schedule an energize date and connect power. As of the energize date CMP will take full ownership of this pole.

Where the pole stands now, is the same distance as similar poles in the area of road. Roughly 12 feet off the pavement. It is placed according to the approved subdivision infrastructure plan previously approved by the town. The pole itself cannot be pushed back any further onto the property, due to a retention pond needed on the site.

Please let me know if I should provide any further information, I can also provide the subdivision plan showing the pole placement.
