The mission of the Town Clerk's Office is to ensure the towns permanent records are recorded and preserved. We prepare for and run elections striving to be professional, knowledgeable, and proficient. We are here to serve the residents and assist them with their daily business in a professional and courteous manner.

We held a Notary Class here at Town Hall, and we had 3 attend from the Clerk's Office and Tax Collection Office, along with 4 from other Town Offices, it worked out great.

On Friday January 24 the Clerk's Office was required to stay open until 5:00 p.m. to accept citizen initiative petitions that might be dropped off for certification by that night's deadline. I stayed but no one came by.

We licensed 880 dogs by in-person and on-line. Pam and Stephanie took on the job of doing all the on-line dog licenses, and it would usually take the whole morning each day to get them done. It is quite a process; it is much easier on us if the people come in, but it is much more convenient for the dog owner if our hours of operation are not convenient for them.

Our absentee ballots came in so we started filling all the requests voters had sent to us ahead of time, and we set a voting booth up in the hallway so people could start voting right here or filling out applications so they could take their ballots home.
