- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Windham has historically sought to preserve land for recreation and environmental needs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Windham has prioritized open space with recreation access over the last three comprehensive plans and now with a newly adopted Open Space Plan; and
- **WHEREAS** the Town of Windham identifies this collected group of abutting parcels totaling over 585+ acres with approximately 1,525+ feet of water frontage on Little Duck Pond dating back to 1700's of primary family ownership and this area has direct influence on our watersheds; and
- **WHEREAS**, these parcels abut the existing 308-acre Lowell Preserve owned by the Town and abuts another 520-acre preserve with our neighbors, the Town of Falmouth and Falmouth Land Trust; thusly creating 1413 contiguous acres, and
- **WHEREAS,** the Town of Windham expects to support hiking, bicycling, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, horseback riding, fishing, swimming, hunting and ATV's and family-based activities on this future and existing preserves.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDHAM, ASSEMBLED THIS ____ DAY OF ____, 2021, THAT:

The Town of Windham Council fully supports the acquisition of these parcels in combination with Federal, State, Land Trusts, Public Water Utility and Town funding.

The Town is seeking \$1,000,000 in supporting funds from the United States Congress' Community Project Funding program through the office of U.S. Congresswoman Chellie Pingree- Balance of purchase price to be raised by Town and community partners.
