I. Council Action Requested.

To approve a liquor license application submitted by the Rotary Club of Sebago Lake for a fund-raising event to be held on May 23, 2019.

II. Basis for Council Action.

- a) 28-A M.R.S.A. §653 requires the municipal officers to act on applications for liquor licenses; or, if they fail to act within sixty (60) days, the application will be deemed to be approved by the municipal officers and ready for action by the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement, and
- b) Pursuant to Article II, Section 1 of the Charter “[t]he Town Council, hereinafter called the ‘Council’, shall be and constitute the municipal officers of the Town.”
