I. Council Action Requested.

To approve a mutual aid agreement for emergency services to aid with public safety emergencies, pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. §3156, with the Town of Gray, and to authorize the town manager to sign the agreement on behalf of the town.

II. Basis for Council Action.

- b) Pursuant to Article II, Section 1 of the Charter “The Town Council, hereinafter called the "Council", shall be and constitute the municipal officers of the Town.”
